

Grams of CO2e emissions per mile in New England





Better for economy

- EVs keep energy dollars in Massachusetts
- Part of least-cost strategy to reach economy-wide climate goals (Synapse Energy Economics 2016)
- Big net societal benefits from increasing adoption of EVs, particularly in public health (MJ Bradley 2016)



Range anxiety is a thing of the past



Lower cost of ownership

- Average new car = \$36,000: EVs cost less with federal and state incentives
- Lower cost for energy
 - Save 4.4 cents/mile or \$528/year by our math
 - Department of Energy's eGallon as of Feb. 20th:
 - \$2.62 regular gasoline
 - \$1.76 electric eGallon
- Lower cost to maintain





More charging stations are on the way


- Volkswagen settlement
 - Appendix C: Electrify America to spend \$1.2 billion in 17 metro areas (of which Boston is one) to install public Level II and DC fast charging
 - Appendix D: MassDEP to receive \$75 million to spend on environmental mitigation projects, of which up to 15% can be spent on EVSE
- "Make Ready" approach
 - Eversource: \$45 million, 500 sites with 4,000 ports over 5 years
 - National Grid: \$25 million over 3 years

Emissions are lower (and will continue to fall)

Renewable Portfolio Standard and Clean Energy Standard (new policy) require more clean energy every year.

- At launch, 11% of our electricity was green.
- In 2018, 16% will be green.
- The percentage of green power will now increase by 2%/year.

You can buy green power to match 25% or 100% of your electricity consumption.
