THE ISSUE

- The amount of food wasted in a year on Earth would feed all 925 million starving people on the planet... **three times over.** -<http://www.fao.org/>
- **1/3** of all food produced on Earth goes to waste.
- The GHG emissions from food waste accounts for almost **6-10% of all GHG emissions.**

RESIDENTIAL

35%-45% of food wasted



RESTAURANTS

25-35% of food wasted



GROCERS

10-15% of food wasted



INSTITUTIONS

5-10% of food wasted



PROCESSORS & MANUFACTURERS

5-10% of food wasted

Source Reduction and Reuse

- Restock products at a reduced price.
- Dont overstock for presentation.
- Use unsellable products for prepared meals.
- Utilize inventory management software

Feed Your Community

- Work with local food banks, shelters, and churches to feed your community,

Feed Animals

- Identify local farms and ask which products they can use as feed.

AD & Energy Conversion

- Work with Agri-Cycle to create renewable energy and soil.
- Oils can be converted into fuel via Agri-Cycle too!

Compost

- Turn food waste into healthy soil
